Stand security manager

Every exhibitor presenting products requiring licences (e.g. firearms and ammunition) on his stand must nominate a stand manager and if possible a deputy stand manager and notify the exhibition management accordingly **before the exhibition.**

We have read and will comply with the instructions on the **prevention of theft, gun security** and the **tasks of the stand manager.**

Prevention of theft, gun security

- Products requiring licences (e.g. firearms and ammunition) must be protected against theft 24 hours a day.
- Short guns and long guns must be secured mechanically with steel cables, chains or other suitable fixing devices.
This also applies to firearms kept in glass showcases.

If the glass showcases cannot be opened by simple means or are equipped with an acoustic alarm, no additional security devices are necessary.

Alternative security measures may be approved after inspection.

- With the exception of dummy ammunition, all ammunition must be kept in lockable containers (glass showcases).
- The permanent presence of stand staff is no substitute for mechanical locking devices.

Tasks of stand manager

- The stand manager is responsible for ensuring compliance with the instructions on prevention of theft and gun security – see above.
- The stand manager is responsible for gun security on the stand between the start of assembly and the end of dismantling (assembly period, during the exhibition and dismantling period) if the guns are not yet or no longer secured in accordance with the regulations.
- **The stand manager or deputy stand manager must be permanently present on the stand during the times stated above.**
- The deputy stand manager may only take over the stated tasks for a short period.
- The stand manager is responsible for gun security for the direct exhibitor and co-exhibitors.

The details provided for the stand manager and deputy stand manager will be used solely by the exhibition management and local authorities for contacting them during assembly, exhibition and dismantling. The nomination of a stand manager is obligatory for exhibiting at IWA & OutdoorClassics 2010.
